"Summery paper"

The Brahma Kumaris celebrates the progress made in raising global consciousness about the triple threat of biodiversity loss, pollution and climate change. However, it may only be a spiritual consciousness that gives us the power to make further advancements.

The United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) (COP 15) is happening at a very critical time. Commitment is needed by all actors for an ambitious, transformative nature positive agreement. The **Brahma Kumaris World Spiritual University** (BKWSU) is dedicated to *Building a Shared Future for All Life on Earth*.

We support negotiations to:

- reverse biodiversity loss and prevent extinctions with ambitious goals and targets;
- ensure biodiversity, genetic resources and digital sequence information (DSI) are shared equitably;
- ensure the role, traditional knowledge and rights of indigenous peoples, local communities, women, youth and other stakeholders are respected and strengthened in decision making;
- address the drivers of biodiversity loss and ecosystem destruction such as industrial agriculture, food systems and fossil fuel industries;
- limit the use of pesticides in agriculture, eliminating the discharge of plastic waste;
- secure financial resources, capacity building and implementation mechanisms to guide member states to integrate the framework into their national conservation plans.

However, we believe this will not be enough.
